Postoperative	Instructions:
0	Someone should stay with you for the first 24 hours following surgery. If you had medication or general anesthetic, it is normal to feel drowsy and weak; therefore, it is not recommended that you drive, stand or walk without help, operate heavy machinery, drink alcohol beverages or eat a heavy meal (due to nausea), make important personal or business decisions or sign important papers; children should not ride bicycles, skateboards etc.
Dentist's Orde	ers:
C	On arriving home: remove gauze packs, take your prescribed medications with a sweet drink such as juice. Moisten fresh gauze with cold water, roll into a ball and place over the extraction site. Bite down firmly for 20-30 minutes. Replace gauze as needed. Bleeding may occur for several hours Drink plenty of fluids and soft food. Increase diet as tolerated.
C	disappear gradually and is no cause for concern. To lessen swelling, apply ice packs for the first 24 hours and thereafter, heat for comfort.
C	If sutures (stitches) are required, they are dissolvable and will disappear within a couple days. If your sutures are non-dissolvable and need to be removed you will be advised. Specific Instructions
C	Take home medications
